Bridgeton Invitational Tournament
Home Run Derby Details

- Participants will be permitted to use *aluminum or wood bats* in the two rounds of Home Run Derby competition.
- Players may bring their own pitcher or use the pitcher provided by the Tournament Committee.
- In the first round each player will have the opportunity to hit until they accumulate 10 “outs”. Any pitch that a player attempts to hit that is not hit out of the park (fair) is considered an “out”.
- At the end of the first round, the top three homerun totals will move on to the Championship Round. In the Championship Round, each player will have the opportunity to hit until they accumulate 10 “outs” once again. Any pitch that a player attempts to hit that is not hit out of the park (fair) is considered an “out”.
- The player with the most homeruns total, after the two rounds, will be declared the Bridgeton Invitational Tournament’s Home Run Derby Champion. In the event of a tie for the lead after two rounds, a supplemental round(s) will determine the winner.
